### OUR VISION

The Company's products must be of a nature to comply with all relevant processing, transportation and use regulations.

### OUR COMMITMENT

The Company will:

- incorporate sustainability and product stewardship in our product and process development efforts in a way that improves safe handling and limits or mitigates any impact on the environment;
- work closely with logistics providers and customers to understand and respond to their evolving needs and to seek ways to improve safe handling and use to further reduce potential impacts on the environment;
- ensure that product stewardship documentation regarding its products, such as Safety Data Sheets are readily available to all stakeholders; and
- provide appropriate policies, standard procedures and training to ensure that staff, and contractors are clearly aware of their respective responsibilities and can perform their duties in the required manner.

### OUR EXPECTATION

Management are responsible for the implementation of this policy and are expected to lead by example.

Product Stewardship practices are the collective responsibility of staff, contractors and visitors.

Working in an acceptable Product Stewardship manner is a condition of employment or contract.

### CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT

MZI will establish deliverable product stewardship objectives, and also measure, communicate and report its performance accurately against these targets.
